## New REMIT Implementing Regulation: Reporting of Secondary Capacity Transactions via PRISMA as of 29 April 2026

Dear Customer,

We would like to inform you about very recent regulatory developments concerning **REMIT reporting obligations for secondary capacity transactions**.

### Regulatory Context

Under Article 8(1) of [Commission Implementing Regulation \(EU\) 2026/256](#) (revised REMIT Implementing Regulation), Organized Market Places (OMPs) are required to report to ACER, on behalf of market participants, transactions resulting from secondary capacity allocations that are carried out or registered on their platform. This applies to all secondary transactions relating to the transportation of natural gas as defined in Article 3(b)(ii), irrespective of where the allocation takes place. In this context, the OMP acts as the reporting party for all relevant market participants.

The revised REMIT Implementing Regulation will enter into force on **29 April 2026**. As of that date, and as confirmed by ACER in its [Open Letter](#), the obligation for OMPs to report such secondary capacity transactions will apply.

### PRISMA's solution for our customers

PRISMA, as a capacity platform, is a registered OMP within the REMIT framework.

To ensure compliance with the revised REMIT requirements, **REMIT reporting will be activated for all shipper customers as of 29 April 2026**.

PRISMA will, by default, report to ACER on behalf of the respective market participants all relevant secondary capacity transactions carried out or registered on our platform.

This provides a consistent and compliant solution for timely reporting under Article 8(1) of the revised REMIT Implementing Regulation.

### What does this mean for you?

If you are already using PRISMA's REMIT reporting service, the current setup remains unchanged. You can of course continue using the service.

If you are not yet subscribed to PRISMA's REMIT reporting service, REMIT reporting will be activated for you on the platform. If, on or after 29 April 2026, you become a party to a secondary transaction subject to REMIT, that is carried out or registered on the PRISMA platform, PRISMA will report such transactions to ACER on your behalf. Please feel free to use our reporting service also to register any of your OTC transactions on the PRISMA platform.

By participating in or registering such transactions on the PRISMA platform, you will be deemed to have accepted and will become subject to the PRISMA REMIT transaction reporting service GTCs in respect

of those transactions, including the applicable reporting service fee. This fee applies only where PRISMA reports at least one transaction on your behalf per calendar year and will be invoiced retrospectively together with any applicable ACER fees for that calendar year.

You will receive a notification via e-mail for each report sent. The REMIT reports including their status will be as well accessible for you via the User Interface on the Platform. Of course, all reports will be processed and stored compliant to the regulatory REMIT requirements.

## Next steps

Updated General Terms and Conditions and technical documentation will be published soon via separate notification. We will also continuously adjust and update our service according to the new and upcoming regulatory REMIT requirements such as ACER guidance, User Manuals, and formats.
